Congratulations on the purchase of your new Power Steam Pro. This is the only hand-held unit for home use and travel that works like a professional model. Here are some tips to help make sure you use the steamer correctly and get the maximum results:

- 1. It is important to **use TAP WATER** in the steamer. Do not use distilled, filtered, bottled, or purified water or reverse osmosis as it will not steam. Distilled water does not contain any minerals, and the minerals in the water are what make it steam.
- In order to get the best results, use 6 measures of water (using the cup included in the box) the first time you use the steamer. Let it run through a complete cycle to initiate and prime the steamer. It may take a little longer than normal to start steaming on the first cycle; warm water may be used for quicker results.
- 3. After the first cycle, continue to use 3 to 4 measures of water. Each time you refill the steamer, it will continue to steam even more because additional minerals are added each time. If you are not getting the desired amount of steam, simply let it go through a couple of cycles to fully prime.
- 4. Be sure to **unplug the steamer before removing the cap** to add more water. **The steam is VERY hot!**
- **5.** Rinse the steamer out after each use to remove the minerals that have collected in the steamer. If you ever want to do a thorough cleaning, simply rinse it out with white vinegar.
- 6. The steamer will work correctly when held horizontally or vertically, but it will cease to work if the front is lower than the back at any time.
- 7. To turn off the steamer, simply unplug it from the outlet.
- 8. If the steamer runs out of water, it will turn off.

Using the Power Steam Pro with Texture Magic™: Because the sole plate of the steamer does not get hot, you may set the steamer right down on top of the Texture Magic™, something you can't do with an iron. You will be amazed at how quickly and easily you can create texture using Texture Magic™ and the Power Steam Pro. Just be sure to keep steaming until the Texture Magic™ side is completely flat. You don't want to see wrinkles or creases in that side. Have fun!

Using the Power Steam Pro as a garment steamer: To take out wrinkles in clothes, you must directly touch the fabric with the steamer. The steamer must be placed onto the fabric (hold the item taut, not tight, but taut) in order to trap the steam. You will find it works best when garments are hanging. Also, keep the nose up when using because the steam diminishes when the steamer is turned onto either side. As with any new system, it may take a few tries to become proficient, but given some practice, you will love and enjoy your new steamer.
